NORTH AMERICA

CANADA

General

With the reopening of Canada's borders to all vaccinated foreigners last month in September a new procedure is in place to help facilitate the increased traffic to Canada's airports. The list of airports for international General Aviation flights allowed entry into Canada are CYYZ, CYC, CYUL, CYVR, CYQB, CYOW, CYWG, CYEG, CYTZ and CYHZ. More Canadian airports are likely to be added as COVID restrictions slowly lift.

USA

General

Handlers at the top ski resort areas at KJAC (Jackson Hole Aviation), KASE (Atlantic Aviation) and KEGE (Vail Valley Jet Center) anticipate heavy volumes at their FBOs as international travel is still limited and domestic vacation travel has radically increased during the Pandemic. Possible ground delays and special instructions from ATC may occur so please contact handlers early to request parking and ground handling and plan for possible long wait times from ATC.

KBGR/Bangor

The popular airport used as a tech stop for North Atlantic crossings and as an ETP will be closed the 4th and 5th of October for taxiway and runway improvements.

KLAS/ McCarran Airport

The NBAA has decided to resume the NBAA BACE in Las Vegas this year on October 12-14. As has been the case every year that the event is held in Vegas the local airports surrounding the area (KLAS KHND and KVG T) are likely to experience large traffic volumes. Contact handlers early to ensure parking and ramp availability are available. All NBAA BACE attendees will be required to show proof of vaccination to gain entry to the event.

MMUN/Cancun – The most popular tourist airport in the Yucatan Peninsula is undergoing major runway improvements and will be closed nightly from 11pm until 7am local time until at least October the 16th check MMCZ Notam A5626/21 as extensions to the runway closure may occur

TXKF/L F Wade Intl- The Atlantic hurricane seasons continues to be a busy one this year with hurricane Sam strengthening into a Category 4 hurricane over the Atlantic during the first week of October. Although Sam is forecast to weaken slightly as it passes to the north of the Leeward Caribbean Islands caution should be exercised when flight planning into this region during hurricane season. If Sam's track changes it may still threaten Bermuda

EUROPE

EICK/Cork

Cork Airport is closed from September 13 to November 22 2021 for major runway repairs. Please plan accordingly.

ITALY

General

SPAIN

GCLA/La Palma

The Volcanic activity continues on the Island of La Palma. Flights to and from La Palma were cancelled, but favorable weather conditions has meant that flights have been able to touch down at the island's Airport in recent days. As of 04th October there are currently no Notams affecting the Airport, however as the Volcanic activity continues this could change with little or no notice. Please monitor Notams for the latest.

Airport will be completely closed to all traffic including medevac, for works reasons, (local times)

AFRICA

ETHIOPIA

General

Reminder Caution - HAAB/Addis FIR have published a Notam closing a section of airspace below FL290 over the Tigray region along the Ethiopia/Eritrea border in the north of the country. This follows reports that militia shot down a military transport plane in the region last week near the capital Mekele.

The conflict appears to be escalating again. Caution should be used if overflying the area, particularly on airways UM656/UT124 between the HSSS/Khartoum and HAAA/Addis FIRs which have previously been closed due to the conflict.

MIDDLE EAST/INDIA

AFGHANISTAN

General

The FAA has extended its airspace warning for Afghanistan for another 12 months. The advice remains, when operating in the Kabul FIR (OAKX) stick to the airways and maintain FL330 or higher. If you have to land, keep the ground time to a minimum.
