

# Brief Yourself Webinar Checklists

## ATCS (Departure)

### A—ATIS/WX

- Review ATIS and verify legality for Departure
- Performance Considerations

### T—Taxi/Runway

- One/Two Engine Taxi
- General Routing/Host Spots
- Surface Contamination/Conditions
- Low Visibility) QRH

### C—Clearance (PDC)/Departure Plan

- Brief and verify ATC clearance/SID or departure procedure
- Weather/Windshear, Anti-ice, Radar
- Terrain/Obstacles/MSA

### S—Specials/Threats

- Immediate return/Divert plan
- Engine out
- Unique Airport Procedures/Considerations
- Any other known risks

## CRAFTS (Arrival)

**C—Configuration** other than standard must be briefed

**R—Runway** specific to your operation, taxi plan to include hot spots and control exchange if appropriate

**A—Verification** of latest **ATIS** (Discussion of weather completed prior to setup)

**F—Fuel** available for holding and diversion

**T—Specific threats** and factors that need to be identified and discussed (terrain, airport conditions, high minimums pilot, etc.)

**S—Discuss special considerations** associated in any non-normal situation

### Ask Yourself: Are You Feeling?

1. Fatigued
2. Rushed
3. Distracted
4. Complacent

Remember: *3 Strikes and You're Out!*
